Test result looks purple or blue: This indicates that your pool water has a very high chlorine content. Discontinue use of chlorine until chlorine returns to normal, or use a chlorine neutralizer. Always tests too high: Repeated test results indicating that the pH in your pool water is high indicates a high total alkalinity. Add a pH decreaser to balance the total alkalinity.
