### Automotive Manual For Flat Rate Times

Most auto repair shops quote labor charges using a "flat rate" manual or computer program that provides the average time it takes an experienced technician to perform a given car repair. That flat-rate time is then multiplied by the shop's hourly labor rate to reach the total labor charge for the service.

Under the flat-rate pay system, the technician is paid by the job. Similar to the example above, if a job that is estimated at one hour takes three, the employee is still paid at the flat rate -- the equivalent of one hour. However, if he completes the work in just 30 minutes, he still receives the full flat rate.
