First check your owner's manual to make sure you know whether a flush or change of transmission fluid is typically recommended for your vehicle. When changing your transmission fluid, you open the transmission drain located on the underside of the car. This allows about 40% to 50% of the transmission fluid to drain out into the pan.

Completely drain the transmission fluid. Connect the transmission fluid pump to a bottle and drain out all of the fluid. Pump a small portion of new fluid into the fill plug to flush out any contaminants. Ensure that you have a little more transmission fluid than the volume listed in your owner's manual.

Honda Accord: How to Replace Manual Transmission Fluid ...

Most manufacturers suggest 30,000 to 60,000 miles as the point at which you should change the transmission fluid in a manual transmission. However, vehicles with transmissions that are under 'high stress' should change the transmission fluid every 15,000 miles.

How Often Do I Need to Replace the Transmission Fluid ...

Like engine oil, transmission fluid needs to be changed at regular intervals to ensure component longevity as well as performance and efficiency. Conventional wisdom from most manufacturers dictates that drivers have their transmission fluid changed at 30,000-mile or two-year intervals.

Close the drain plug and tighten it, then pump fluid in through the fill hole. You can either use a fluid pump, or you can route a hose from the top of the engine, then connect it to the transmission fluid bottle, and let gravity do the work for you.
