1. Story Reading into Writing. Children who read plenty of memorable stories avidly and repetitively, or are read a regular Zbedtime story, will implicitly internalise language patterns. Many of these children have the skill to draw on this resource for their own writing.

Story Reading into Writing - Talk for Writing

Without understanding the connection between sounds and letters, a person cannot read. The connection between reading and writing can help solidify these skills in young readers. Parents and teachers should help children “sound out” words in both their reading and writing.

Integrated Skills in English (ISE)

The Reading & Writing exam takes 2 hours and has four parts: Task 1 — Long reading - one long text and 15 questions; Task 2 — Multi-text reading - read 4 short text and answer 15 questions; Task 3 — Reading into writing - write an essay or an article based on the four texts in Task 2. 100–130 words
