Storyville was the infamous red-light district behind the French Quarter, along Basin Street, between Canal Street and St. Louis Cemetery No. 1. It operated from 1897 until 1917, when, with World War I raging, the U.S. Navy forced the city to shut it down.

The Beauties of Harrison Fisher. Basin Street was the scarlet thread through New Orleans, the principal artery of the red-light district, for almost a half-century. All illegal (but highly profitable) activities were moved into a restricted district along Basin Street, next door to the French Quarter. Quickly nicknamed Storyville, the district boasted fancy "sporting palaces" with elaborate decor, musical entertainment, and a wide variety of ladies of pleasure.
