Show your child/student(s) that you are happy to see them. Smile at them when they come into the room; for parents...put your arms out for a hug. Ask about their day, weekend, etc. and really listen when they talk. 5. Remind your child/student(s) that they should be proud of themselves (e.g., "You worked so hard on that science project. You should be so proud of yourself!").

## **10 Simple Ways to Improve Children's Behavior (Home/School)**

Set up expectations ahead of time and allow your child to earn privileges for following those expectations. This is much more effective for encouraging compliance than punishing your child or taking away privileges when they don't do what you want them to do. Let your child have a say in what they want to work for.
